



Packing instructions

Pack the Insured Item tightly in a durable package according to the regulations of international postal traffic. Seal the item with sealing tape or stickers across all edges in such a way that the content of the item cannot be tampered with without leaving signs. The use of transparent parcels and window envelopes is not allowed.

Write the sender and receiver information as well as the insured value and the value of the goods on the wrapping of the sealed item. The item may be furnished only with labels and stickers pertaining to postal and customs formalities. None of them may be folded over the edge of the item.

Cover box-shaped items with white paper where you write the address information, the insured value, the postage fee and any postal or customs indications. Seal the package. If an inner box is required for the content of the item, use a box made of wood, metal or plastic.
